RESOLVED THAT IQAC would enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Uttaran and would aim to do the following

1. Spreading awareness and consciousness on socially relevant issues
2. Appreciation of inter-temporal and inter-spatial issues
3. Delivering workshops by resource persons on yoga, public health
4. Counseling and rehabilitation of physically challenged students
5. Provision of physical aids to physically challenge students
