Skill Plus

Context

The students in the Sunderbans comes from socially challenged families and thus most students during their childhood had a very little opportunity to receive guidance, training, counselling and mentoring by parents at home to unearth the pent up potentiality buried in them

Goal

The college aims at providing guidance; training, counselling and mentoring to the students so that the students feel encouraged to reflect their potentiality through sustained efforts of mentoring by the teachers to the students in the classroom and outside the classroom

Efforts

1. The college has introduced and running UGC - CPE Skill Plus Programme
2. Principal as Mentor of Mentors encourages the teachers to rise above the role of being "only teacher" in the classroom and assume the role of Mentors to guide and counsel the students round the year
3. IQAC organizes several students' centric programmes, contests, events and functions around the year so as to provide opportunities to the students to participate and perform in such events
4. Mentors imbibe strong self-efficacy belief – "I can do" – and enable them to perform in the following programmes
