Dr Suchandra Biswas - IQAC Coordinator requested the Principal to explain each of the items on the Agenda

Agenda 01 - Matter related to Ranking framework - SWACHATA, NIRF

At the very outset members congratulated the Principal for being selected as the Resource Person of MHRD visiting team and for his visit to two universities in Jharkhand for Ranking of Higher Education Institutes on the basis SWACHATA parameters

Principal shared his experience of his visits to two different universities and made reflections of such experience in the context of the Bankim Sardar College. After making such reflections Principal advocated the idea of making the college apply for SWACHATA ranking in the year 2019.

All members discussed the several parameters of evaluation namely - student/toilet ratio, availability running water, modernity level of toilet, garbage clearance units, hygiene, greenery and maintenance, rainwater harvesting systems & solar power use, overall ambience, look & cleanliness, village adoption and its cleanliness - and felt encouraged to accept the idea proposed by the Principal

RESOLVED THAT Principal would take up the matter with the Administrator adopt appropriate resolution to fulfill the two pronged strategy

1. Build toilets separately for boys and girls in each floor of the college main building, college annex building, and RUSA building

 Campus Green and Clean Committee to maintain flower gardens and kitchen gardens and to engage staff for cleaning and dusting

Principal also emphasized on the importance of getting the college introduced to the NIRF as that would put the college into the path of development that is required for better ranking in the NIRF. It is also emphasized that taking part in NIRF is a reflection of good governance. Members readily agreed to the view expressed by the Principal and identified the parameters wherein IQAC is required to place focused emphasis so as to develop the college in such directions.

RESOLVED THAT Principal would take up the matter with the Administrator to adopt appropriate resolution to apply for NIRF during 2018 and subsequently would develop the college in the following directions

- 1. PhD to be encouraged
- 2. Publication Patents and Projects to be encouraged
- 3. Placement for progression to be encouraged

Principal invited the views and opinions of the Members present in the meeting as to when and how to conduct the Cultural Exchange Programme for the year 2018-19. After detailed discussion it was agreed upon that the college may consider organizing either of the following programme

- 3. A visit to another CPE college (Mukberia College Midnapore) and take part in exchange programmes
- 4. A visit to a college in the North East (Union Christian College, Meghalaya) and meet the students of the seven North Eastern states

RESOLVED THAT Principal would take up the matter with the Administrator and upon obtaining approval would communicate with Principals of other colleges and find out means and ways to make any of the cultural exchange programmes possible
