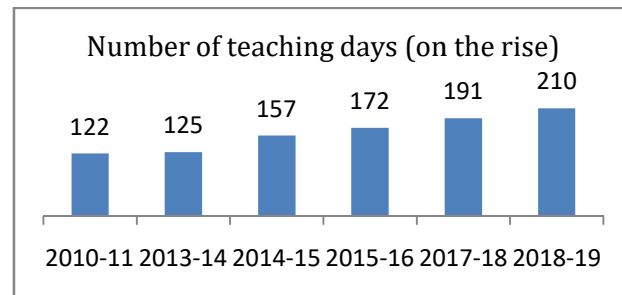
Transition to CBCS – the Change Management

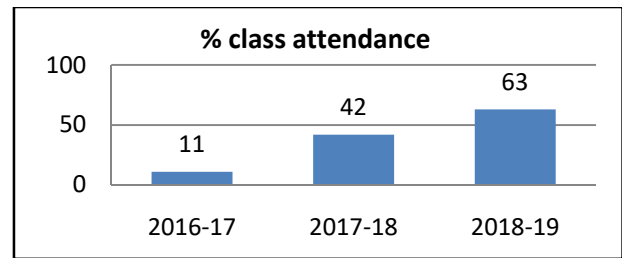
Continuous Internal Assessment

Whereas the affiliating university required every college to take one internal assessment during the end of each semester this college conducted continuous internal assessment every month. The marks scored in such internal assessment are than uploaded in the college portal for parental viewing.

College has been able to encourage the students to come to classes in large numbers by way of adopting several students' friendly measures.

Large numbered classes are divided into smaller sections so that students find a seat to sit in the classroom. The college has also provided back to back classes and the class timings of students of 1st /2nd Sem, 2nd year and 3rd year" remained mutually exclusive so that dearth of classrooms is not felt. The students face high cost of commutation because of the geographical disadvantaged location of the college. To mitigate such financial difficulty the students are provided with the opportunity of completing 100% of the 75 hour classes as required under CBCS by coming to the college on three days per week with the option of coming to college on the other the three days for library work, tutorial classes and add on training.

TOWARDS EMPOWERMENT

The college appreciates that it has the crucial role to play in empowering the students with skills that are required in workplaces and life. The students of this region in general come from underprivileged families and never had any formal training for skill development and perhaps never had the mentoring and guidance about their abilities. Thus they require both **training and mentoring**. The college thus introduces several training programmes – THE SKILL UP PROGRAMMES and the round the year mentoring programme – THE SKILL PLUS PROGRAMME.

IQAC organizes several students' centric programmes, contests, events and functions around the year so as to provide opportunities to the students to participate and perform in such events

Principal encourages the teachers to rise above the role of being "only teacher" and encourages them to assume the role of Mentors to guide and counsel the students round the year for the purpose of making the students feel that "even I can do."

Female Empowerment

The college is imparting lights of higher education in the region of Sunderbans, where the general tendency is one of giving greater priority to son child in the question of providing higher education. During 2013-14 percentages of female students enrolment was as low as 34.2% which means 2 out of every 3 students taking admission in the college were male students. This college has its core value as Vidyā Vimuktaye, which means Education which Emancipates and liberates from all darkness and bondages. We appreciated the need of enlightening the "parivars" of this region and making them encouraged to send their daughters to the college by way of emphasizing on the value of Higher Education for the Girls. Vidyā Vimuktaye is getting reflected as the female enrolment have risen to 48.7% in 2018-19

Encouraging artistic skills

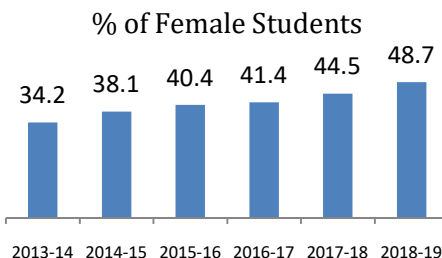
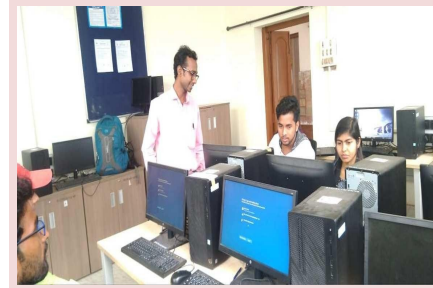
Mentors encourage the mentees to take part in several performing art competition
